

Rediscovery Drug & Alcohol Treatment Program
ADMISSION CRITERIA

The Our Home, Inc. Rediscovery program will accept individuals with substance abuse and dependence disorders without discrimination in regard to race, color, gender, religion, ancestry, national origin, disability or co-occurring disability.

1. Applicants must be between the ages of 12 and 18 years of age.
2. Applicants must meet the current DSM diagnostic criteria for substance abuse or substance dependence.
3. Applicants must be screened and assessed as appropriate for admission according to the American Society of Addiction Medicine criteria; specifically criteria for participation in Level III.7 care.
4. Applicants must have sufficient intellectual capacities such that they can be reasonably expected to benefit from participate in the therapeutic and educational services provided.
5. The Rediscovery Program welcomes people with co-occurring disorders (applicants with co-occurring diagnosis other than Chemical Dependency diagnosis). The Program Coordinator may require additional information and documentation as to the nature of co-occurring conditions so as to assure for the safe and appropriate care of the individuals considered.
6. Applicants can be tentatively admitted for the purposes of evaluation. Admission appropriateness for an emergency admission may be made based on “available data”.
7. Payment arrangements must be established prior to admission.

Applications must be submitted prior to admission to allow for Program Coordinator and Treatment Team review to determine admission eligibility and appropriateness.

Admissions are generally prioritized on a first-come, first-served basis. But if needed due to the applicant's status, the admissions will be prioritized by:

- Pregnant injection drug users
- Pregnant substance abusers
- Non-pregnant injection drug users
- Harmful use (using inhalants several times a day)
- All others
